Footnotes

BIG BOY ARTIE vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide around the bend, edged clear mid stretch, was then fully extended to hold off KAYAKER at the wire. KAYAKER rated and saved ground around the turn, angled out mid stretch taking aim, surged late just missing in a very game try. HEIR RAISER dueled with the winner form the start, hugged the rail alternating for the lead to mid stretch, came up a bit short late, good try. FLASH FOREVER lacked speed and saved ground, angled out top of the lane, did improve position but needed more late. LIVINGSTON'S GHOST hustled stalking early on running three wide, failed to respond despite being hard ridden, no late threat. MARKUM raced evenly at mid track, swung six wide into the lane, failed to menace. EXCLUSIVE ELUSIVE varied little racing mid pack, came five wide into the lane, lacked surge. AMBER DUBAI broke awkwardly and rider lost his right iron, got his foot back in the stirrup on the far turn but was far behind, raced eight wide top of the lane, made up ground in the stretch but never factored.
