LEX'S SHADOW sent clear set the pace through the turn, hooked from the inside in upper stretch would cede the lead then battle back gamely late. Lyla Dawn stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied inside to put a head in front in upper stretch then dueled to wire being out gamed late. JUSTLIKESUE slow early rallied on the turn gaining five wide there, lost momentum in upper stretch finishing evenly. CRAFTY VICKI broke awkwardly trailing the field through the turn, angled five wide in upper stretch had modest improvement. START THE BAND slow early came six wide to upper stretch finishing evenly. BEL AIR BABE slow early played no factor. GONE WEST AZIZ flashed early speed then faded on the turn. CARNELIAN gave hard pursuit through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. TAKE THE PRESS raced mid pack through the turn then wilted in upper stretch.
