PROUD HONOREE hustled to the front, set a well rated pace, repulsed challengers from upper stretch, held sway late under a drive. TRIPPI RHYTHM stalked the winner early on, moved to the rail top of the lane, almost drew even inside the eighth pole, was turned away late proving second best in a game effort. AWESOME AFFAIR hopped at the break, settled in the second flight, launched rally coming five wide into the lane, closed willingly nearing the wire picking up the show position. WINABULL tracked down the backside, bid four wide at the quarter pole to loom off the winner, failed to sustain move and hung late being outfinished for a minor placing. A BRIDLED TIGER lacked speed and raced along the rail, found stride mid stretch, was gong well at the finish but never threatened. HOLY ARMENIA stalked along the rail to the quarter pole, angled out top of the lane under a drive, lacked rally and tired in the drive. DAKOTA FREEWAY lacked speed racing mid track throughout, failed to factor. BRONX BULL settled in mid pack running towards the inside, urged form mid turn, lacked response and tired in the lane. GIFTS FOR A KING settled in the second flight, faded entering the stretch offering little.
