Footnotes

KEY TO WINNING came in crowding IRISHWOODS causing a chain reaction of jammed rivals near the eleven sixteenths pole, drew clear on the turn widening into upper stretch being ridden out in the two path. IRISHWOODS was cut off by KEY TO WINNING checking then coming in causing a chain reaction of impeded rivals near the eleven sixteenths pole, regrouped nicely chasing the winner in willing fashion through the stretch. CAPOTE BULL was squeezed and forced to check near the eleven sixteenths pole, raced evenly through the turn holding position along the inside the final eighth. MOBIL DREAMER was jammed and forced to check near the eleven sixteenths pole, dropped back after with little recovery. CHIPPED pressed and chased KEY TO WINNING through the turn then wore down along the rail in upper stretch. GOING STICK was jammed along the rail bobbling while checking near the eleven sixteenths pole, stayed back after. PROPER'S ACE chased the pace through the turn then gave way along the inside in upper stretch. AN OBJECTION FROM THE RIDER OF IRISHWOODS AGAINST THE RIDER OF KEY TO WINNING FOR INTERFERENCE NEAR THE ELEVEN SIXTEENTHS POLE WAS UPHeld BY THE STEWARDS. KEY TO WINNING WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND.
