Footnotes

GOLD FABULEUX well placed out of the opening turn, followed hurried pacesetters to the 1/2 mile pole, angled out while prompted to action on the far turn, took the lead then was challenged by MIDNIGHT CHARMER who had moved up on the outside, took the measure of that one drawing clear under a drive. MIDNIGHT CHARMER rated off a quick pace, advanced outside the 1/2 mile pole, circled out to loom off of GOLD FABULEUX into the stretch, went fully extended down the lane, turned away proving second best. JEANIE SUE raced evenly from the break, swung out tracking 5 wide to the 1/2 mile pole, continued to lose ground vying all out into the stretch, wore down in mid drive hanging on late for third. DESERT CONQUEST unhurried early on, raced well back to the 1/2, roused to action showing some life on the far turn, gave steady response through the lane finishing well. ACCENT OF GOLD away slowly, labored along near the back to the far turn, kept along the inside to the stretch, had some belated action near the rail. I HEAR THAT was outrun early, remained well back throughout playing no factor. WESTERN MISS rushed out for the early lead, pressed abreast CHANTRE as the pair posted fast splits to the 1/2, began to wear down under pressure outside the 1/4 pole, folded up at the head of the lane. MISS BARNER away slowly, labored far back to the stretch. CHANTRE hustled out to engage WESTERN MISS on the early pace, was hard used on quick splits down the backside, had enough entering the far turn folding up at the 1/4 pole. MISS SIG was always outrun before tiring.
