CUBAN CARMEN was patiently ridden traveling mid pack, launched rally mid turn running towards the inside, angled out to the three path upper stretch, drove by a stubborn PRIZE FEVER mid stretch and was kept to task holding safe. PRIZE FEVER battled with CHILE TEQUILA from the start, these two raced as a team to the half setting a sold pace, cleared that rival leaving the far turn and opened up a large lead at the quarter pole, was being reeled in by the winner in upper stretch, battled gamely to the wire ceding stubbornly in a very game effort. WHY US raced unhurried for five furlongs, gained momentum coming to the quarter pole, angled out three to four wide upper stretch, gained show position in a willing effort. DANCINGTHENITEAWAY lacked speed and raced along the rail throughout, was under a stiff drive turning for home, showed belated interest but never threatened. DESSERT FIRST tracked the pace running mid track, bid mid turn chasing a lose leader, flattened out mid stretch. CHILE TEQUILA sent hard dueling with the runner up to the half, gave way entering the stretch, finished spent. DEL BONITA was always outrun, eased mid stretch but completed the course.
