BACKGAMMON broke alertly pressing a short lead through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch then held on while a bit weary late near the rail. NICKY'S DELIGHT went evenly through the turn coming four wide in upper stretch, responded late surging three deep at the wire. MADLY PADDLIN HOME pressed then chased through the turn, bid gamely going all out between horses late. FIRST NITE tracked the pace through the turn racing three path to upper stretch, angling down to the two path gave an even finish. RIDIN' HARD slow early saved ground finishing with interest along the rail. PETER THE GROSS broke sharply pressing the pace through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading in the three path. WILLIE BAGS played no factor. SPORTING REBEL retreated on the turn.
