Footnotes

SAY AMEN rated early, sat patient to mid turn, followed BLAZING COUNTESS from the three eighths pole, waited to top of the lane and then swung widest to mount rally, collared SHOWMESOMELOVE and BLAZING COUNTESS near the 1/16 pole, surged up in last strides for the victory under good handling. BLAZING COUNTESS was bumped and jostled soon after the start, trailed to the half, angled mid turn, rallied quickly while 4 wide at the quarter pole, dueled racing between foes in deep stretch, was outbid nearing the wire in a very game effort. SHOWMESOMELOVE was rated in mid pack, asked far turn, put in a strong bid mid turn to take the lead, was under an all out drive in mid stretch, was involved in a three way battle at the 1/16 pole, out gamed in last strides. HASTY was hustled and set a pressured pace while racing off the rail, was headed near the 1/4 pole, dug in briefly but weakened in upper stretch. SUNSHINE SUMMER was sent hard, stalked throughout while 3-4 wide, chased near the 1/4 pole under a drive, weakened in mid stretch. SHE A TULSA GIRL raced up close early along the rail, asked and vied mid turn for the lead, weakened in upper stretch while under a drive. I SAID NO raced up close for a half, traveled between foes on the the turn, angled in upper stretch, tired form the eighth pole. ON A DREAM raced evenly towards the rail for the first half, weakened far turn, was all done after six furlongs.
