Footnotes

BLUEGRASS DREAMER pressed for the lead racing inside a pair of rivals while traveling in the two path, vied in a three way battle at the quarter pole, shook clear in upper stretch, drew off from mid stretch, widened margin under steady handling. STELLAR HOPE rated early and raced towards the inside throughout, put to a stiff drive from the quarter pole, moved into second place chasing the winner in upper stretch, never threatened and dug in late saving the place position. LIGHTNINGFASTMAN unhurried leaving the gate, trailed to the far turn, split foes at the quarter pole and swung out four wide top of the lane, finished willingly just missing second place. MR. CLASSIC SPIRIT hustled from the gate, held a slim lead racing between foes from the start, fought gamely to the quarter pole, began to give way in upper stretch, faded from mid stretch besting rest. PROMETHEUS tracked the pace racing along the rail, loomed briefly midway on the second turn, started to give way leaving the quarter pole, vanned off after the race. HOMERSRUN vied for the lead racing three wide abreast foes to the far turn, battled gamely to the quarter pole, began to drop off in upper stretch, gave way at the furlong marker finishing spent. CASARAH hustled and raced in good tracking position briefly, began to fade on the turn, finished being eased across the wire. GOJIRA was off slowly, raced towards the rear throughout, showed little finishing being eased across the wire.
