**Footnotes**

CAMBRIA QUEEN settled nicely tracking a hot pace, came four wide into the stretch, put to strong left handed stick and slowly wore down duelers and inched clear late, was all out coming to the wire and just held on fully extended. SAHMBA LA VISTA unhurried running in the second flight along the inside, angled out past the quarter pole, came five wide from upper stretch, closed strongly nearing the wire to just miss in a hard effort. I'M FLATTERED was hard ridden leaving the gate, battled for command along the rail soon after the start, matched strides to the sixteenth pole, weakened late in a game effort. LALIQUÉ raced towards the rear running mid track, urged coming seven wide into the lane, found best stride too late finishing in a willing manner. BELLA RITA was outrun to top of the lane, found stride upper stretch, finished with interest but never menaced. WALTZING TIME broke sharply but was headed by I'M FLATTERED going down the backside, matched strides to upper stretch, had enough and gave way inside the furlong marker. REMEMBERYOURPLACE raced up close throughout, loomed off duelers at the quarter pole, could not keep pace form mid stretch,faded late. GOTTA LUV CARROTS raced in the second flight, failed to respond when roused, never factored. SHE'S DUE FOR ONE well placed going down the backside, started to give way turning for home, used up. SCRATCH TURNS raced five wide in mid pack, gave way top of the lane, spent.
