QUIETLY WAITING moved on pace shaking clear into the turn, widened the edge in the two path upper stretch then dug in from the rail holding on late. TIME TIX AHEAD raced evenly off the pace through the turn, bid three path upper stretch, surged inside the sixteenth pole pressing hard at the end. RED OAK RIDGE stalked the pace laying close to upper stretch, vying in the three then two path fired gamely from between horses in the final yards. OH SO LO brushed early was outrun through the turn, angled out in upper stretch closed belatedly at mid track. STARLITS TOUCH slow early stayed back through the turn, extending in the three path down the stretch found best stride late. SARAVA RULES outrun through the turn saved ground to upper stretch gaining a bit late along the rail. HARD TWO IMAGINE sent hard pressed and chased under hard asking through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. GHOSTOFGLOORY slow early played no factor. FORTUNE FADED gave way rapidly on the turn, was eased to the wire.
