Footnotes

SEARCH was patiently handled down the backside, made a quick four wide move entering the stretch, took aim on OUTERBANKS in upper stretch, blew by that rival to win going away. OUTERBANKS stalked to mid turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole taking over, was no match for SEARCH inside the eighth pole proving a willing second best. BARBARA'S CHOICE settled in the second flight, bid four wide top of the lane, chased top pair to the wire, finished evenly taking the show position. POLISH SAUSAGE was outrun to the quarter pole, came off the rail turning for home, bumped with BATKAS' BOB two times in upper stretch, angled to the rail mid stretch, hit best stride and finished strongly but too late. FAST FLING well placed down the backside, lost position mid turn, bid between foes mid stretch, lacked needed rally. PRINCE OF BETHANY sent hard and held a slight early lead, began to weaken top of the stretch, gave way from mid stretch. PHILLIE'S CHAMP broke well vying for the early lead racing between rivals, started to tire entering the stretch, used up. BATKAS' BOB was outrun racing along the inside, bumped twice with POLISH SAUSAGE in upper stretch, put away from there .
