Footnotes

COVERT ACTION well placed from the start, bid three wide mid turn heading IRISH GENTLEMAN at the quarter pole, dueled to mid stretch, slowly edged away under strong handling. IRISH GENTLEMAN broke alertly but was soon pressured for the lead, headed by the winner near the quarter pole, fought hard running along the inside throughout the stretch run, yielded grudgingly proving second best. DUTY ROSTER unhurried from the gate racing along the inside to the quarter pole, angled under a drive turning for home, needed a bit more besting rest. JETABILITYPROSPECT well placed early on, mounted bid running three wide at the quarter pole, held menacing position top of the stretch, angled towards the inside leveling off mid stretch. BLACKFEET tracked down the backside, came five wide under a drive, lacked surge. LIL PERFECT STORM rushed soon after the start pressing IRISH GENTLEMAN down the backside, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, weakened in the lane. SUN RISER was always outrun racing mid track, never involved.
