Footnotes

WIND WHISPER raced up close from the start, bid along the rail leaving the far turn, led mid turn and turned away JAKES STORM BUCK entering the stretch, widened own on accord to win in hand as much the best. GENERAL STALLINGS lacked speed running mid track, urged at the quarter pole, hit stride top of the lane coming five wide, closed willingly securing second place but never threatened the winner. JAKES STORM BUCK stalked to mid turn, made a bold three wide bid to loom off the winner at the quarter pole, proved no match form mid stretch and was outfinished late vying for second place. STARLITS LAD settled along the rail, mildly bid mid turn, chased entering the stretch, flattened out in the drive. CHANGE YOUR BET raced evenly traveling three to four wide, lacked response never threatening. HOLD THAT KING broke alertly grabbing the lead, headed mid turn, quickly faded from the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch and was eased to the finish line. FANTASY TEMPTY struggled early on, raced far behind in a dull effort.
