SOUP OF EARL broke alertly wresting then nursing a short lead through the turn, hooked on the outside by CHARLIE'S RAINMAN down the lane dug deep to prevail. CHARLIE'S RAINMAN went evenly through the turn circling out to bid six wide in upper stretch, angled in bearing down on SOUP OF EARLY late to no avail, was vanned off after the race. REBELS ROOST hustled out pressed and chased SOUP OF EARLY through the turn, was weakening when checking briefly between horses a sixteenth out dropping off there. DIABLO GUAPO was brushed ducking out at the break, trailed through the turn then picked up some position racing six wide through the lane. BEMINEONVALENTINE gave hard pursuit through the turn then faded in the three path upper stretch. BROKEN POST veered out at the break, close early would drop from contention on the turn. EYEFUHR brushed at the break would press early then give way on the turn.
