Footnotes

ITALIAN REVOLUTION was patiently ridden in the early stages, angled out leaving the quarter pole, came six wide upper stretch, blew by duelers in deep stretch to arrive in time. CATMOOCHIE raced up close from the start, bid three wide at the quarter pole, put a head in front mid stretch, fought hard but was run down in last jumps missing in a hard effort. SHES SWISH raced up close to a contested pace, came thru a narrow opening top of the lane, drew even mid stretch vying for the lead, was outfinished by top pair in last strides. PORT OF GOLD unhurried and trailed to mid turn, swung seven wide upper stretch, hit stride late giving a belated surge. BRIGHTEST CRYSTAL was never far off the pace racing between foes, lacked needed kick. NA KELLY hustled from the gate but failed to respond, settled towards the rear, raced five wide into the lane, angled in mid stretch, lacked rally finishing evenly. BREEZY DOES IT was hard used early making the front, angled inside setting a pressured pace, was all done inside the eighth pole, faded late. ABITA INDIGO lacked speed, raced inside form upper stretch, offered little. FOXY FRAULINE pressed for the early lead running between foes on the bend, began to give way mid stretch, finished spent.
