Footnotes

IMA DEMON TOO sent early, pressed outside rival, edged clear lane, dug in late, withstood heavy pressure. POLLYS SUNSHINE prompted pace, dueled inside foe, overtaken to lane, kept willing to wire. HIGH MAINTAINANCE rated off pace, roused into turn, hit stride late, closed fast. PRETTY SPORTY rated back, middle move, swung to mid track, lacked punch. FAIR FALCON dropped back, sluggish to 1/2, altered course, some late action. RIVER RALLY sat off early duel, loomed to 1/4 pole, leveled off. RAINY LEX slow early, taken wide. CORDON NEGRO went evenly, flattened out. WEALTHY KEY outrun, tired.
