Footnotes

RUMMY'S COMMAND was slow into stride, rallied near the quarter pole, came five wide vying for the lead in upper stretch, edged clear and was kept to task holding safe. NOS MAN raced up close from the start, bid in tandem dueling on the turn, fought hard racing inside the winner from upper stretch, was outgamed late and settled for second best. READY TO POUNCE tracked early on, mounted bid coming to the quarter pole, was in tight and had to wait for room entering the stretch, split foes upper stretch and vied receiving sever left handed stick, needed a bit more late in a hard effort. IFPUSHCOMESTOSHOVE pressed early on running along the rail, fought hard to mid stretch, came up short a sixteenth out beating others. ONLY HIM (GB) settled in the second flight, swung six wide under a stiff drive top of the lane, failed to menace. VY VY VY lacked speed and raced wide throughout, failed to factor despite being hard ridden. FOUR BOOTS sent hard setting a pressured pace, dueled to the three sixteenths, gave way inside the furlong marker finishing spent.
