CREDIT CRUNCH raced up close to a contested pace, bid three wide mid turn, headed A LITTLE TASTE at the quarter pole, matched strides to deep stretch, slowly inched clear under a stiff drive, held firm late. A LITTLE TASTE hustled early, set a pressured pace running a little off the rail, dug in once headed by the winner, fought hard to deep stretch, yielded grudgingly, saved place at the finish in a very game effort. LIL ERMA JEAN forwardly placed running towards the inside, angled to the rail mid stretch, almost drew even nearing the wire, missed in a hard effort. COURBET unhurried and trailed racing mid track, found stride upper stretch, closed willingly but never menaced. NOBLE PARADISE tracked under a rating down the backstretch, rallied four wide top of the lane, chased in the drive needing more late. POWER GRACE settled in mid pack and saved ground throughout, hard ridden from top of the stretch, failed to threaten. LIONS N LEGS broke a bit outward, settled in the second flight, roused from mid turn, failed to respond. THE NATIVE BLAZE pressed the runner up down the backside, chased form the quarter pole, was all done and gave way mid stretch. TIMELY HIT lacked speed, was briefly steadied near the three eighths pole, never factored.
