Footnotes

CRAFTY MATCH raced along the rail throughout, began to close the gap on loose leader near the eighth pole, wore down ROCKER CHAD in deep stretch to win going away. ROCKER CHAD sprinted clear going down the backside racing off the rail, opened large advantage at the quarter pole, held an apparent safe lead mid stretch but became leg weary at the sixteenth pole, faltered nearing the wire and held on to second place. WAGON LOAD stalked loose leader running three to four wide around the bend, chased under an all out drive from upper stretch, did narrow the gap late but needed a bit more in willing try. GLACKITY GLACK hustled racing in good stalking position, failed to respond when asked, bested rest. ANTARCTIC lacked speed and raced off the rail throughout, did mildly improve placing but never threatened. WILDMAN MAC flashed good early speed stalking the runner up down the backside, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. INCREDIBLE PLAY rushed a mild bid midway on the turn, gave way in upper stretch, no factor. REAL EASY was outrun racing wide throughout, offered little.
