AWEEONEINTHEBUNKER stalked to the far turn bid three wide to vie for the lead, edged clear past the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage mid stretch and held safe under steady urging. RAVEN BEAUTY rated from the gate, raced towards the inside to the far turn, angled out and waited for room on the bend, came four wide top of the lane, was hard ridden in the drive and gained second place in deep stretch. WITCH TOWN was off slow and trailed in the opening strides, rushed along the rail to track, angled out three wide to chase the winner entering the stretch, could not make any headway in the final furlong and was edged out of second place nearing the wire. LEXI'S ARGUMENT raced well off the rail throughout, put to a stiff drive from the quarter pole, failed to menace. KNOTTS settled early trailing for the run down the backside, came five wide under a drive into the stretch, failed to menace. KNOCK OUT PRINCESS hustled leaving the gate, pressed briefly for the lead racing between rivals, began to weaken turning for home, no late factor. HAYLEY'S BAYLEY was hard used leaving the gate, headed by the winner leaving the far turn, battled to the quarter pole, weakened from upper stretch, used up.
