Footnotes

MS. DEANDRA rushed form the gate, cleared at the five eighths pole, set the pace while in the three path, asked for more entering the stretch, held sway under steady handling to the wire. WILDABOUTAUNTY was unhurried and settled in the rear along the rail, advanced near the quarter pole, closed ground willingly to gain the place position. ULTIMATE DIVA broke alertly, was out sprinted for the lead, stalked the winner throughout, angled towards the inside under an all out drive upper stretch, failed to rally and was out finished late, settled for the show position. NATIVE HEARTBEAT hustled and stalked early, angled out under urging top of the lane, was empty in the drive. OFFTHEBENCH lacked speed, raced mid track, hard ridden entering the lane, did improve placing late but was no threat. MILITARY MISSION raced in good tracking position while off the rail, out to a drive mid turn, chased into the stretch, had no kick and weakened in the drive. ITS TUESDAY flashed speed leaving the gate, chased to the far turn racing wide, failed to menace and gave way mid stretch. TOUR'S ENERGY raced evenly in the second flight, was hard ridden far turn, lacked response and dropped off never factoring.
