SUNSHINE KID settled early gave a prompted middle move bidding clear into the far turn, hand ridden down the lane would widen in the two path, pulled up bad and was vanned off. RAVENSWORTH stalked the pace close up through the backside, dropped off on the far turn angling to the four path in upper stretch, responded late coming on to salvage place. DUTY ROSTER gave a prompted middle move chasing through the far turn, still a threat in upper stretch would finish evenly in the three path. ALLENSWORTH sent clear set a modest pace through the backside, overtaken into the far turn would chase from the rail in upper stretch wearing down late. BAYLAND slow early gained on the backside then leveled off on the far turn. SUNSHINE BO stalked the pace through the backside then gave way on the far turn. COOL CLUE hustled along stayed close early then wilted after a half mile. BACKTRACKEN struggling well back was pulled up at the head of the stretch and vanned off after the race.
