BID'S REWARD hustled up early worked on a short lead through the turn, engaged from the outside by VALIENT TENOBOB in upper stretch would drift out on rival under left hand urging holding on late. SINGINGWITHANGELS broke alertly pressing then chasing BID'S REWARD through the turn, extended on the inside down the stretch found more staying on to the end. VALIENT TENOBOB stalked the pace drawing closer on the turn, moving to even terms abreast BID'S REWARD in upper stretch was carried out by the angling leader checking near the wire. CHON raced evenly off the pace through the turn, taken six wide in upper stretch improved a bit late. BROTHER KEITH reared up missing the break, saved ground hustling through the turn, showed some late life in the two path. AMERICAN CLASSIC chased the pace through the turn then wore down the final eighth. SMOOTH TRANSITION a step slow throughout labored racing seven wide through the lane. DOC LA POINTE was decisively outrun. An objection from the rider of VALIENT TENOBOB against the rider of BID'S REWARD for interference during the stretch run was disallowed by the stewards.
