Footnotes

HELLO MAMA stalked the pace through the turn rallying to hook IN SHORT ORDER from the outside in upper stretch, couldn't shake rival needing full extension in the final yards. IN SHORT ORDER sent clear set the pace on a steady margin through the turn, hooked on the inside by HELLO MAMA in upper stretch would dig in battling rival to the end. STAND WITH ME stalked early then dropped off on the turn, went evenly in the two path the final eighth outbidding the others. LETS SNEAK IN slow early angled four wide in upper stretch giving a mild late response. SEEKING BRANDY slow early saved ground to upper stretch finishing evenly along the rail. DIGGIN FASTER raced a step slow through the turn angling six wide in upper stretch finding little there. ANNE S folded up on the turn. BROKE GAMBLER done early was eased the final eighth jogging to the wire.
