SECRET BROOK showed high speed from the gate, quickly gained control, set solid fractions throughout, responded well when asked for more entering the stretch, held sway under strong handling. DUAL DIAGNOSIS nicely rated, saved ground, rallied leaving the quarter pole, swung five wide upper stretch, was closing fastest of all at the wire to narrowly miss in a game effort. DEADWOOD DAME raced in good stalking position, traveled along the rail throughout, angled out deep stretch, closed the gap on the winner nearing the wire in a willing manner. SASSY SURPRISE was outrun to the quarter pole, hit stride in upper stretch, finished with interest along the rail but was no threat. AURA LEE hustled and stalked SECRET BROOK from the start, chased under urging at the quarter pole, lacked bid and gave way near the eighth pole, used up. CUTUP was forwardly placed, raced a little off the rail, asked leaving the quarter pole while angling out wide entering the stretch, came up empty in the drive never threatening. MY SISTER NORMAN raced evenly at mid pack, hard ridden into the stretch, no bid. MISS CUPCAKE broke outward, was hustled to track the pace to mid turn, asked from there, had no response, tired mid stretch. EL ESTRELLA raced evenly towards the inside, roused but never responded, no threat. OCEAN'S AWAY lacked speed, raced wide, urged mid turn, never factored.
