MOONSHINE BAY tracked the pace to mid turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole, raced abreast a pair of rivals top of the lane, put a head in front inside the eighth pole and slowly edged away under aggressive handling to the finish line. ON TOUR pressed for the lead from the start, gained a slight lead in mid stretch racing between foes, was outgamed by the winner late and settled for second place in a very hard try. JOHNNY JOE was sent hard from the gate and maintained a slight lead to upper stretch racing along the rail, fought gamely to deep stretch, ceded stubbornly just holding on to third place. AMAZING SPIRIT tracked a contested pace saving ground to upper stretch, angled out under a stiff drive mid stretch, finished willingly just missing third place. BOY G. lacked speed racing off the rail, came five wide upper stretch, lacked rally never menacing. GATORS CHOICE well placed stalking to mid turn, began to weaken entering the stretch, no factor in the stretch run. MIDSHIP MAMBO was always outrun, swung very wide top of the stretch under a drive, never factored.
