Footnotes

RED DWARF quickly cleared and angled to the rail, held a comfortable lead in mid stretch, was kept to steady urging in deep stretch as the margin was diminishing. DUBAI MISTAKE settled in mid pack, set down under a drive swinging out five wide top of the lane, rallied willingly grabbing the place position late. STORMY DUDE broke well pressing the winner in the early stages, gave chase running along the rail, was outfinished late missing second place while just holding the show position. LAGOON stalked running along the inside throughout, mounted bid in mid stretch, leveled off late being outfinished for a minor award. KEY REVERSAL trailed went the backside, came six wide in upper stretch, bid belatedly but was no real threat. RUNFORGLORY stalked around the turn traveling in the three path, failed to respond when asked for more top of the stretch, weakened in the lane. SNACK DADDY settled in the second flight, raced between foes mid turn, gave chase in the lane running towards the inside, lacked needed surge. STOW IT raced evenly in the second flight, lacked rally when asked for more, tired in the drive never menacing. ESSON was in close and brushed shortly after the start, settled in the second flight, raced three wide and between foes in mid stretch, tired never factoring. LEROY'S DEPUTY was always outrun racing wide.
