GOODNESS GREYCIOUS stalked early pressing up to take the lead on the turn, digging in from the two path down the lane held to outside pressure late. IT'S GOTTA BE US tracked evenly through the turn gaining to loom in the three path upper stretch, extending late pressed the winner late. SMOOTH TOWN broke sharply pressing early then chasing on the turn, angled four wide in mid stretch surged late. SHORE TEE away alertly pressed on the inside through the turn, all out into upper stretch would weaken on the rail. LIVELY EXIT slow early saved ground to upper stretch finishing evenly on the rail. GRUBBY'S GIFT played no factor. TALK TO DA MANAGER steadying after the break was no factor. PAUL BUNYAN was always outrun. HOLY HIGH VIKING gave hard pursuit through the turn then wilted while drifting in on upper stretch.
