FAX THE PAIGE well placed, moved on turn, circled out into lane, blew clear. FREE TICKET sent hard, contested for lead through turn, overpowered in drive. PAPIER MACHE went evenly, mild rally to 1/4 pole, even response in drive. ALYCHOIS slow early, outrun on turn, minor rally stretch. SNEAKY sent hard, pressed for slim lead, all out to lane, folded late. TORRENTIAL QUEEN slow early, never involved. KIP ALONG MOLLY away alertly, chased dueling rivals into turn, wore down. ESTROGEN EXPRESS went evenly, weakened. VIVID BRIDGET off slowly, always outrun. RED RIVER SHOWDOWN offered little.
