ENERGY COUNTS broke alertly, controlled the pace throughout, asked for more entering the lane, drew off under energetic handling for a convincing victory. SUDDEN BURST hustled and pressed the winner to the quarter pole, proved no match from mid stretch, gamely saved the place position under a drive. PRINCESS BUCKAROO tracked the pace along the rail on the turn, gained ground top of the lane, chased the winner in the lane, was out gamed late for the place position, settled for the show position. FAVORITELY raced evenly while saving ground, was hard ridden in the lane, improved placing but was no threat. PORT OF STONE raced evenly, roused and swung five wide into the stretch, lacked late kick. KIDDER DONE hustled from the gate, tracked while four wide, had no response and tired at the eighth pole. WOODEN YOU lacked speed, asked at the quarter pole, failed to factor. KONA SUNSET was outrun racing wide, showed little.
