Footnotes

NO MORE BEER crowded at the break began to respond in mid turn moving up quickly racing six wide into upper stretch, briefly lost path as STATELY CLOCK drifted out sharply near the eighth pole, angled in a bit surging clear late at mid track. LIVELY EXIT ducked in sharply leaving the gate, settled off the pace rallied at mid track near the eighth pole, ducked out when struck with a left hand whip coming on late to save place. STATELY CLOCK moved evenly early advancing five deep on the turn, taking a short lead abreast rivals into upper stretch would drift out sharply, trying to regroup racing nine wide would hang late. CELTIC FIRE slow early saved ground through the turn cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, responded willingly along the rail giving good action to wire. BLACKJACK GAMBLER hustled out giving hard pursuit through the turn, bid extended at mid track in upper stretch, came up a bit short. MEYER sent hard along the inside, wavered at the three eighths pole dropping off while angling out into the turn, continued on evenly from the five path posing no menace. HILL ROAD DANCER played no factor. MR. CAPOTE sent hard pressing CLIF'S STORM into the turn, dueled briskly there carrying the battle to upper stretch, would wear out in mid drive. CLIF'S STORM broke sharply working under pressure to keep a head in front through the turn, ceded when weary in upper stretch. RUSTIC RIDGE showed little.
