BOBS TIEBREAKER sat off a hotly contested pace, made a quick bid entering the far turn running three wide, drove clear and opened up mid turn, won easily being ridden out. TWO DRAGONS rated and raced mid pack, rallied three wide on the bend chasing the winner, never menaced but was a game second best. CHALK EYED CAT unhurried and trailed to mid turn, angled towards the inside beating tired rivals bit was no real threat. GOLD CACHET settled in mid pack, roused from mid turn, failed to threaten. WEST LONG BRANCH dueled to the half setting a rapid pace, began to fade leaving the quarter pole, used up. WILD PURSUIT lacked speed, swung six wide top of the stretch under a stiff drive, failed to respond, no factor. SAVTHELASDANCEFOME battled for the lead to the far turn, was all done leaving the quarter pole, finished spent.
