PURE RUSH broke alertly and was confidently handled setting the pace, turned away FUN IN PARADISE entering the stretch, drew off being ridden out. DIP MY BEAK settled in the second flight, rushed a bold four wide bid to loom at the quarter pole, leveled off upper stretch, came again late securing second place. FUN IN PARADISE raced up close throughout, bid and vied outside the winner near the quarter pole, proved no match from the eighth pole and tired late to settle for third best. AKUMAL BEACH BOY rushed and pressed for the early lead, was in tight entering the far turn and checked hard losing position, angled four wide trying to re-rally, finished in willing manner. WERBLIN FRIEND was hustled early, stalked to the quarter pole, lacked kick in the drive. LIES AND AFFAIRS was a step slow and raced towards the rear, failed to factor. ITZA MAKER stumbled badly and took up at the start, never recovered, no factor. PLUS OR MINUS was hard used in the early going, started to fade near the quarter pole, used up.
