LAZY NATHAN sent from the gate, duelled with MESSENGER SPRINGS to top of the stretch, drew off and was kept to task holding safe. EFFERVESCENT CHARM tracked early while angling to the rail, mounted threat top of the lane, proved no match late but was a game second. MESSENGER SPRINGS duelled with the winner to top of the stretch, yielded stubbornly mid stretch, dug in preserving the show position in a hard effort. TRIPPI RHYTHM settled towards the rear, came six wide entering the stretch, found stride too late, finished fastest of all. FLY BY MOONLIGHT raced up close around the bend, angled three wide and moved to a menacing position at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and flattened out late. CANALI unhurried early lagging towards the rear, swung seven wide in upper stretch, found best stride too late, finished with interest. SIRR PURR raced in mid pack, came five wide top of the stretch, battled for a minor placing from mid stretch but was outfinished needing more late. LAHAVE was quickly outrun racing wide down the backside, offered little. SOME KIND OF MAGIC raced briefly in mid pack, lacked response when asked and faded in the lane. CITY CODE hustled and gave a brief chase, gave way near the quarter pole.
