HIGH ACT hustled to the front, set a pressured pace traveling towards the inside, increased margin from mid stretch under steady encouragement. FIRE RIDGE stalked the winner from the start, loomed at the quarter pole, was turned away inside the furlong marker holding place in a game try. HEADLINE rated early racing towards the rear, rallied four wide into the lane, got up for third late needing a bit more. THE ONE TO CHASE raced along the rail in mid pack, gained top of the lane holding a menacing position, failed to sustain move and leveled off being outfinished for a minor award. TEBOW GO raced mid pack while off the rail, came five wide entering the stretch, failed to threaten. NEVEREVERYIELD broke awkwardly and stumbled shortly after the start taking up, settled towards the rear, failed to respond when roused, no factor. DAKOTA FREEWAY varied little racing between foes towards the rear. DRAW PLAY raced up close traveling three wide, lacked rally and faded from upper stretch. STORM THIS gave a brief chase running four wide, retreated mid turn and finished well beaten.
