Footnotes

COOSADA was patiently ridden in the early going, bid in tandem near the quarter pole, raced four wide between rivals upper stretch, dueled outside a drifting LAGOON OF DIAMONDS in deep stretch, edged away late under strong handling. LAGOON OF DIAMONDS angled inside shortly after the start, rushed to vie for the lead along the rail leaving the far turn, dueled in a three way battle near the quarter pole, edged clear upper stretch, began to drift out mid stretch despite receiving severe right handed stick, was outfinished late and settled for second best in a hard effort. UNSTOPPABLE MICK was off a step slow, trailed down the backside, bid with the winner mid turn, came five wide into the stretch, loomed at the eighth pole, was outfinished late in a good try. MORAL COMPASS raced along the rail throughout, failed to menace in the drive. TROOP SUPPORT was hard used going down the backside, vied in a three way around the turn, had enough and gave way mid stretch, used up. MARYLOVESTETON raced up close soon after the start, was in tight and brushed the rail at the five eighths pole steadying briefly, angled out far turn, bid three wide mid turn to loom off duelers, began to fade in upper stretch, no late factor. PUTITALLTOGETHER showed good early foot dueling briefly, dropped off abruptly mid turn, finished spent.
