TAXICAB angled out early rushing up to challenge on the turn, shook clear in the two path upper stretch holding sway. AUDITORIUM was squeezed by PATRICK N DYLAN checking early, lost ground gaining to upper stretch, bumped BEAR'S CONDUCTOR near the eighth pole then came on gamely while drifting inside late. SIRR PURR slow early varied little through the turn, gave a mild rally in upper stretch holding position late in the three path. BEAR'S CONDUCTOR was squeezed by PATRICK N DYLAN checking early, rallied on the turn then was bumped by AUDITORIUM in upper stretch dropping from contention after. ONE VOTE away slowly was outrun through the turn, improved past tired ones upper stretch. HOLY HIGH VIKING pressured the pace through the turn then gave way in upper stretch. READY TO POUNCE hustled out pressed the pace through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. CHARLES THE HAMMER was always outrun. PATRICK N DYLAN lugging in early played no factor. IFPUSHCOMESTOSHOVE chased early then gave way on the turn.
