VOLPONI DRAGON tracked a loose leader to the far turn, quickly reeled in that rival mid turn, drove clear opening up a large in upper stretch, won easily and was vanned off after the finish. IRISHWOODS tracked the pace traveling off the rail, gained leaving the quarter pole, chased the winner to the wire but never threatened, finished a willing second best. EL PATRONE rated early and raced towards the rear, rallied while splitting foes turning for home, settled for third place and was no serious threat to top pair. RATHER QUICK unhurried and raced towards the rear, passed tiring foes improving placing but never factored. GOLANI RULES quickly showed in front, set a solid pace opening up on the field at the half, was headed by the winner mid turn, had nothing left leaving the quarter pole, gave way in the lane. A. P. CONQUISTADOR flashed brief speed running along the rail, gave way leaving the far turn. SOUTHERN SEBRING tracked to the half racing three to four wide, gave way midway on the second turn. GENERAL STALLINGS was quickly outrun, raced wide throughout, dull effort.
