Footnotes

SHOT OF KELA stalked the pace edging closer on the turn, wrested the lead near mid track in upper stretch holding clear while drifting in a bit late. ARCHIE TRUCKER slow early angled out to upper stretch, responded at mid track gaining while angling in late to salvage place. HE AIN'T RIGHT broke alertly working to keep a short lead through the turn, hooked along the inside in upper stretch would wear to pressure. PRECIOUS DUKE hustled out would press then chase through the turn into upper stretch, extending in the two path came up a bit short. JOT EM DOWN chased early then dropped off on the turn. PLEASANTLY GOLD slow early played no factor. TOWER OF LONDON dropped back early trailing through the turn, taken seven wide in upper stretch improved little. LETTHEBIGTIMESROLL sluggish early would fail to respond.
