**Footnotes**

PICTURE PLEASE away a step slow, was hustled advancing to mid turn, found room 4 wide to collar rivals inside the 1/4 pole, took charge with outside position drawing off under a drive. MT. MARGARET sent hard contesting the early pace, dueled between horses through the turn, hooked from the outside by PICTURE PLEASE inside the 1/4 pole, proved no match going extended along the inside to save place. D. J.'S SLEW off slowly, labored along trailing the field through the turn, found stride inside the 1/4 pole, gave a strong closing surge 4 wide. PERSIAN PRINCESS hustled out pursuing a hurried pace, gave urged chase abreast rivals through the turn, extended in bid at mid track in drive, gradually wore down. FASHIONABLY LITE away slow raced sluggishly through the turn, circled 5 wide to the lane with minimal improvement. TON A RUN sent hard engaging the early pace, pressed full out 3 wide on the turn, began to waver when joined from the outside by PICTURE PLEASE near the 1/4 pole, gave way between horses mid stretch. HATCHETSFLYINGIRL rushed hard brushing PEEKABOO SEZ leaving the gate, pressed a moderate pace going all out at the rail, hung in to the 1/4 pole before folding up. PEEKABOO SEZ bumped by HATCHETSFLYINGGIRL leaving the gate, rushed with early speed to the turn, gave way outside the 1/4 pole. I THINK I CAN couldn't go with the early pace, wilted soon after entering the turn.
