CLASSIC CHANT quickly showed in front, set all the pace running along the inside, asked for more entering the stretch, responded to increase margin being kept to task. PATENT PENDING settled in the second flight, steadied briefly on the turn avoiding spill, closed willingly proving second best. JITTER IN ROME tracked to mid turn, was put to a stiff drive from the quarter pole, improved but needed a bit more late. RIVER SAAR showed good speed, pressed the winner to mid turn, could not keep pace entering the stretch, tired mid stretch. MY GRECIAN GODDESS raced towards the inside in mid pack, mildly rallied top of the stretch, failed to sustain move leveling off vying for a minor award. BLAH BLAH BLAH lacked speed racing towards the inside, failed to threaten. LOOSE LIPS stalked running four wide around the bend, began to tire mid stretch, no late factor. WYNNING CARD hustled and raced up close to the lead going into the far turn, took a bad step breaking down and fell. MOTHER COUNTRY lacked speed, jumped spill on the turn losing the rider.
