JANNA'S SON stalked HONOUR ABOVE SELF from the start, closed in turning for home, drove clear and moved off the rail upper stretch, increased margin under steady handling. HONOUR ABOVE SELF sent hard and cleared going into the far turn, traveled three wide around the bend, headed by the winner entering the stretch, fought gamely to mid stretch, ceded stubbornly but held well late saving second place. LIL PERFECT STORM saved ground throughout, put to a stiff drive from the quarter pole, improved placing picking up the show position. TWOFIVEFIVESLEW unhurried early racing towards the rear, swung six wide upper stretch, showed belated action. SILVER MAN CAN settled in mid pack, raced four to five wide throughout, lacked needed surge. GINGERS LADD hustled racing in good stalking position, chased under an all out drive top of the lane, lacked rally and tired in the drive. VISION OF MONEY lacked speed, failed to respond, no threat. UNSUNG ANGELS was quickly outrun, dull effort.
