HOSTILITY broke sharply to clear the break, hustled along off the inside moving alertly to the stretch, responded with more under a drive holding firm to the wire. REVOLUTIONARY ACT sent hard 3 wide into the turn, loomed off a hurried HOSTILITY coming 4 wide into upper stretch, went fully extended through the lane proving second best. COBRA LADY couldn't go with the early pace, circled out on the turn, rushed 6 wide into upper stretch, remained willing settling for best of others. NATTITUDE outrun from the break, varied little through the turn, mustered a mild rally along the inside in drive to outbid rest. PICCOLO HONEY hustled out chasing HOSTILITY into the turn, gave 4 wide pursuit racing on the outside of REVOLUTIONARY ACT to the 1/4 pole, asked for more near mid track in upper stretch, was worn down wilting to wire. SHANNONS VALENTINE dropped back early, trailed the field through the turn while never involved. SPRING RUSH bobbed slightly at the break, sent hard angling inside to the turn, pursued from the rail, wavered outside the 1/4 pole, folded up into the stretch. GABRIELES PRINCESS came sluggish from the gate, had a laboring journey.
