CITY CODE broke alert wresting a short lead into the turn, challenged from the inside by JACKETY JACK through the lane would hold firm. JACKETY JACK broke sharply pressing then stalking CITY CODE through the turn, looming along the rail down the stretch couldn't get to a determined winner. FORMAL TESTIMONY pressed early then dropped off the leaders on the turn, extended along the inside down the lane vied evenly late. GREAT FACTS hustled out gave hard pursuit through the turn then weakened in upper stretch. MY FIRST CHOICE slow early played no factor. SIXTH FORMAL was always outrun. FOREST LIGHT dropped off on the turn with no recovery. TWISTED FORTUNE showed little.
