**Footnotes**

MOONSHINE JUSTICE broke alertly, dueled inside of MADLY PADDLIN HOME down the backside, came out into the four path entering the stretch, was kept to steady pressure holding safe. FLIP FLOP settled leaving the gate, asked near the quarter pole, came five wide trying to split foes entering the stretch, angled towards the inside when MOONSHINE JUSTICE remained well off the rail for the drive, ran up on that rival in deep stretch steadying briefly, continued on in willing manner proving second best. THE RIDER OF FLIP FLOP CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF MOONSHINE JUSTICE FOR INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, AFTER REVIEWING THE TAPE, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED. MADLY PADDLIN HOME sent hard, pressed MOONSHINE JUSTICE to the quarter pole, could not keep pace from upper stretch, settled for third best in game effort. DRAW PLAY well placed from the start, put to a drive from the quarter pole, chased entering the stretch, failed to menace lacking rally. LANDRY unhurried early, hard ridden from the quarter pole, lacked response, never threatened. TRICKS OF GLORY bobbed at the break, was put to the whip going down the backstretch, lacked response while racing wide, never factored.
