CLASSIC CITY DIVA was patiently handled while angling to the rail saving ground to the quarter pole, roused coming five wide entering the stretch, found stride and quickly blew by in deep stretch to win going away. ORIENTAL BELLA set a pressured pace traveling a little off the rail, held clear lead in deep stretch but was overpowered in last jumps by CLASSIC CITY DIVA forcing to settle for second best in a very game effort. PENN STAR pressed the runner up on the turn almost drawing even, vied to mid stretch, ceded grudgingly late besting rest. LEVA MAE tracked a contested pace throughout, hard ridden from top of the lane, did close the gap some in mid stretch but needed more late. SHE'S MY DIARY flashed brief foot, gave way near the quarter pole, no factor. BLAZINETT was always outrun, never involved.
