MORENO STAR pressed JULES CAESAR for the lead to the far turn, moved clear mid turn traveling off the rail, angled out four wide in upper stretch, held all rivals safe under strong urging to the finish. POLITE LIL SIR settled in mid pack, rallied to a menacing position in mid stretch, was kept at bay by the winner just holding onto second place. TEXAS HOLLADAY tracked early on, came under a drive entering the stretch taking aim on the winner, loomed with a furlong to go, leveled off just missing second place. ROMAN SUR settled in the second flight, mildly responded from upper stretch slightly improving placing but never threatened. JUSTIFIER rated and raced towards the rear along the inside, showed some late action in deep stretch but was no real threat. THRU THE DESERT settled in the second flight, came out six wide into the lane, offered little. BETTER BELIEVE raced up close to the winner to the quarter pole, angled out wide giving chase top of the lane, lacked rally weakening in the drive. ONE VOTE was always outrun, showed little. JULES CAESAR sent hard taking a narrow early lead, battled to the quarter pole, was all done and gave way at the eighth pole.
