Footnotes

VANEASTO matched strides with SKIPPY DUDE for six furlongs, shook clear entering the stretch, won under strongly handling in a very determined effort. TALK IT OUT saved ground throughout, bid mid stretch looming off the winner, was held safe by the winner but gained place position in a willing manner. BATTLE MOUNTAIN rated and raced towards the rear to mid turn, split foes mid stretch, was out gamed vying for second place in last jumps. LIGHTNINGFASTMAN lagged far off the pace, found best stride too late finishing with interest but failed to menace. SKIPPY DUDE dueled with the winner for six furlongs, began to tire in upper stretch, no late factor. MR. CLASSIC SPIRIT stalked a pair of duelers traveling three wide to the far turn, asked for more mid turn, loomed off the winner at the quarter pole, flattened out upper stretch. STORM BY raced evenly in the second flight, failed to factor. HOMERSRUN raced evenly to the far turn, gave way at the quarter pole racing wide.
