Footnotes

SOMETHING SUAVE set all the pace traveling a little off the rail, repulsed PERFECT HONEY mid turn, drew off in upper stretch, held safe under steady encouragement. GOLD INGOT settled in the second flight, launched rally from mid turn, came six wide into the lane, finished willingly proving second best. NO EXPOSURE well placed throughout, saved ground around the bend, failed to menace despite being hard ridden, got the show position in last jump. PERFECT HONEY hustled into the first turn, stalked the winner down the backside, bid to loom at the quarter pole, was turned away by upper stretch, vied for minor awards in deep stretch, was outfinished late besting rest. REAL CASUAL was sluggish in the early going racing mid track, moved out wider entering the stretch, did find belated stride to improved placing but was no real threat. REGAL INDU raced evenly at mid pack, bid coming to the quarter pole, gave chase running between foes from upper stretch, lacked late surge. KATIES MARK lacked speed, roused to no avail, never factored.
